- **Trampolines** -Resident responsible to secure to trampoline to ground to prevent being blown away in high winds. Resident can be held responsible for any damage caused to person or property if blown off their lot

- **Portable basketball goal-** Must be placed in driveway only-NOT in Right-of-Way (street or sidewalk). Resident can be held responsible for any damage caused to person or property if blown over. Must be kept upright at all times- not permitted to be laid on ground or driveway




